"Kibougaoka Cultural Park" is multipurpose cultural park for a range of activities including sports, culture, and outdoor activity, which is located in Shiga Prefecture, some 50km northeast of Osaka and some 400km west of Tokyo.

ATTENDANCE

500 Scouts and leaders from all over Japan, some 100 Scouts/Guides and leaders from other countries and some 400 Agoonoree HQ Team.

Scouts/Guides and leaders from other countries must be registered members of their own National Scout/Guide Organization, and their application must be approved by their National Scout/Guide Organization.

ELIGIBILITY

The Agoonoree programmes are designed for the Scouts with special needs and youth assistance Scouts aged 12-18.

AGOONOREE FEE

The Agoonoree Fee is 29,800- Japanese Yen (approx. US\$430.00 as of January 2012) per person, which covers rations for 12 meals starting from dinner on 2 August and programmes during the camp.

Other expenses, such as transportation between Kansai International Airport or other ports of entry and the Agoonoree site, and cost of touring in Japan are the responsibilities of participating overseas contingents.
