Proposal for Agenda item for 21st European Scout Conference

Dear Friends in Scouting,

The Guides and Scouts of Norway are proposing that "Relationship between WAGGGS Europe Region and WOSM European Region" should be added as an agenda item at the 21st European Scout Conference.

The recent external evaluation of the joint work between WAGGGS and WOSM gives a clear indication that the future joint work needs thorough discussion. Naturally, the Joint Conference will be the main arena for discussions and decisions on the joint work. However, we believe that joint work should also be raised as an agenda item at the WOSM Conference. We hope that the European Scout Committee can share its ideas and future vision for the joint work. And furthermore that all NSOs, both SAGNOs and WOSM-only, will have sufficient time for discussions and preparation before the joint conference.

Matters on joint work may also be treated under agenda item Regional Scout Plan, but we believe that it would be helpful for NSOs, wanting to submit resolutions on this topic, to have designated agenda item. A similar request has been raised for the WAGGGS Conference.

Furthermore, recommendations from the Joint Conference will stand stronger if similar motions and resolutions are accepted by the WAGGGS and WOSM Conferences, and therefore will make it easier for the two committees to work with joint themes in the coming triennium.
